## Youth Programs Supported by Rotary

Nagy Ibrahim introduced the speaker of the day, Roger Mignosa. He was a recent graduate of UCI who had spent a year on a Rotary Ambassadorial Scholarship at the University of Queensland in Brisbane, Australia.

Rotary supports two types of Scholarships. The Peace Fellowship is a two year program in International Studies about conflict resolution. Eight Universities around the world participate in that program.

The Ambassadorial Scholarship program he participated in is either a three to six month, one year or multi year program. His host Club in Australia was the Fortitude Valley Rotary Club near Brisbane and he attended the University of Brisbane.

He described many experiences including this participation in triathlon events, travel throughout Australia and a money raising service project he was involved in honoring an Australian doctor who has killed in a helicopter during an aid mission in Indonesia.

Mr. Mignosa is currently employed at Hoag Hospital as an Exercise Physiologist and has applied for admission to medical school.
