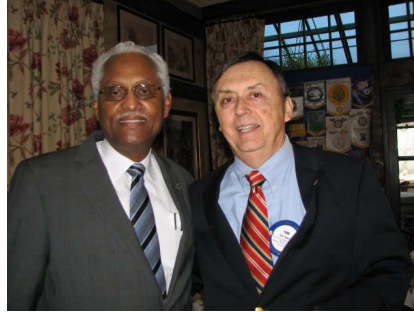
### [Webster Guillory](#) [Orange County Tax Assessor](#)

JoAnn DeBlis introduced her neighbor and the Assessor of Orange County, Webster Guillory. Mr. Guillory advised that his office assesses the values of homes, sport complexes, airplanes, vacant land, attractions, business equipment, hotels-timshares, boats, office buildings, golf courses, retail centers and apartments. Orange County is number 5 in the US via population with 888,770 parcels of real estate. Proposition 8 (1980) allows the Assessor to lower values. Mr. Guillory went through and explained

all the propositions which affect the valuation of property and even Proposition 58 which a transfer between parent and child.
