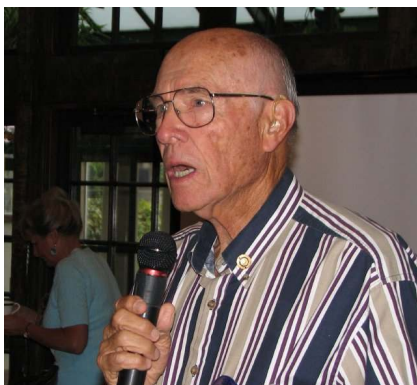

Willis Longyear introduced Alexander Dolitsky, Director of the Alaska-Siberia Research Center. Mr. Dolitsky was born in Kiev, received Masters degrees in history and anthropology from Kiev Pedagogical Institute in Russia and Brown University in the US. He taught social studies and archaeology in Russia, applied for US citizenship and has made his home in Juneau, Alaska.



Alexander Dolitsky, Dir. Alaska Siberia Research Center

Mr. Dolitsky became an associate professor at the University of Alaska and taught throughout the Alaskan school system. He has conducted research and lectured all around the globe, founded the Alaska-Siberia Research Center, where he spearheaded the concept and construction of the WWII Alaska-Siberia Lend Lease Memorial in Fairbanks, and organized its dedication with great international pomp and circumstance in 2006. He has published many books on Siberian history, folk lore and society, and recently chaired a symposium on "History of the Russian Diaspora in the United States and its Impact on US – Russian relations," which he spoke to us about today.

A book will be donated to Newport Beach Library in the name of Alexander Dolitsky, as well as his book which he is donating to the library.
